Niagara County Department of Health has issued a beach advisory at Krull Park beach.

This advisory has been issued for Krull Park and is anticipated to remain in effect until further notice.

Niagara County, New York, 06/18/2008: Recent surveillance testing by the Niagara County Department of Health at Krull Park beach has determined that the water is not suitable for swimming because unsatisfactory bacteriological water quality. This advisory is anticipated to remain in effect until further notice. The Niagara County Department of Health will continue to monitor the situation closely and will reopen the beach when conditions return to a safe level.
