Subject: Change in Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) clinic schedule

Beginning Monday October 6, 2008, Niagara County Health Department will be extending the hours for the Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) clinic. Clinics will be held every Monday and Wednesday from 10:00 am 3:30 pm at the Trott Access Center, 1001 11th Street, Niagara Falls, NY 14301, with the exception of holidays, when the county offices are closed.

Services are available for anyone 12 years of age or older. No appointment is necessary and clinics are free and confidential.

Confidential testing and treatment is offered for Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, Syphilis and other sexually transmitted diseases. Treatment is provided as indicated, based on results of examination for genital warts, genital herpes and other conditions such as genital lice and scabies. Niagara County also offers Hepatitis C screening for high-risk clients, as well as Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B shots for clients aged 19 years and older.

Niagara County Health Department will provide confidential or anonymous HIV testing at the request of the client. HIV post-test counseling and referrals are available for all clients. For more information about the clinic, you can call (716) 278-1900
