(North Tonawanda)

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for the exercise of considerable vigilance in directing traffic for the protection of children on the way to and from school. Instructions and training are given initially by the Crossing Guard Supervisor and thereafter a School Crossing Guard generally works independently with only occasional direction. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

1. Assists children crossing street;
2. Instructs younger children concerning proper places for crossing streets and precautions that are to be observed.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:
Good powers of observation; ability to be firm, yet courteous with the public; ability to get along well with children; familiarity with first-aid methods; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: None are required.
