**LOCAL LEADERS TO MARK FORESTVIEW SENIOR VILLAGE OPENING
ROSS, MAZIARZ TO CELEBRATE MILESTONE IN WHEATFIELD**

WHO: Niagara County Legislature Chairman William L. Ross, C-Wheatfield, Sen. George D. Maziarz, R-Newfane, Kenneth M. Franasiak, Calamar president and CEO.

WHAT: Presiding over grand-opening ceremony and ribbon-cutting.

WHERE: Forestview Senior Village, located on the grounds of The Woodlands Corporate Center East/Woodlands Residential Village, 3959 Forest Parkway, Wheatfield (off of Shawnee Road, just north of Niagara Falls Blvd.).

WHEN: Friday, Feb. 12 at 11 a.m.

WHY: Calamar has created a 92-unit affordable senior apartment facility as part of The Woodlands Residential Village, a 26-acre, 300-unit, \$30 million development. The apartments will accommodate individuals aged 55 and older, and provide them autonomous living facilities. The new apartments are the final part of a three-phase development that represents one of the largest senior housing facilities in the region. Calamar is also utilizing a unique *a la carte* program of services and goods for tenants, called SELF (Seniors Empowered to Live Fully).
