TATTOOING, BODY-PIERCING, AND PERMANENT MAKEUP IN NIAGARA COUNTY

As per Chapter XVIII of the Niagara County Sanitary Code, the following thirteen establishments have received Permits to operate as Tattoo/Body Piercing Establishments in Niagara County:

Under the terms of the permits, these establishments may conduct tattooing, body piercing, and/or permanent makeup procedures at these facilities. The artists affiliated with these establishments have been tested and certified by the Niagara County Department of Health, demonstrating an adequate knowledge of bacteriology and aseptic technique, to assure that infection and contagious disease shall not be spread.

If you, or anyone you know, has recently had a tattoo, body piercing (except for the ear), and/or permanent makeup procedure in Niagara County by someone who has not been certified and/or is not on the list above, please contact the Niagara County Department of Health at **439-7444**. You may do so anonymously. Current information regarding those establishments with permits is updated periodically on our website at http://www.niagaracounty.com/Health/Tat_BP_PMU.asp. Also provided on the website is a copy of the most recent inspection of all permitted facilities along with general information on tattooing and body piercing.

If you are practicing any of the aforementioned without a certificate, or at an unpermitted facility, please contact the Niagara County Department of Health as soon as possible at **439-7444**. There will be a brief period of amnesty, to end March 31, 2009, so that we may assist you in complying with the regulations in the Code. The Code is accessible on our website under the Forms/Regulations section.

General questions regarding tattooing, body piercing and permanent makeup can be directed to the Environmental Health Division of the Niagara County Department of Health at **439-7444**. The Environmental Health Division is responsible for providing education and enforcement of the regulations.
