The Cancer Services Program of Niagara County partnered with 2 local businesses to encourage people 40-64 without health insurance to get screened for cancer. Budwey's Supermarkets in North Tonawanda and Newfane are displaying information at each checkout and brochures are available at the service desks for those who would like more information. Stedman's Nursery in Newfane also invited the Cancer Services Program to set up a table and display information regarding the services available. The Cancer Services Program is a grant-funded program through the Niagara County Department of Health. The program offers free breast, cervical and colorectal cancer screening to those 40-64 who have no health insurance or a high deductible with their health insurance. Those who are eligible can get free screening and follow up care along with a gift upon completion of screening. More information about the program is available by calling **278-8285**.
