- In response to recent events surrounding animal activists indications of “rescuing” farm animals, the Niagara County Sheriff's Office would like to remind farmers and livestock owners to be vigilant for any suspicious activity on their property.
- If you see any suspicious vehicles on or around your property, attempt to get a description of suspicious vehicle, including license plate if possible. If the vehicle leaves the area prior to the arrival of law enforcement, try to get a direction of travel .
- Get description of suspicious persons including race, sex, and other physical descriptors.

- Report any and all suspicious behavior to law enforcement immediately either by **calling** 716-438-3393 or 911 in an emergency. Do not attempt to engage suspicious people or vehicles.
- Make sure you have your property secured as best you can. Keys removed from vehicles, property illuminated as best you can.
- If it is safe to do so, attempt to gather photographs or video for law enforcement to use in the investigation.
