RESOLUTION APPROVING ENGAGEMENT OF OUTSIDE AUDITING FIRM FOR PROFESSIONAL AUDITING SERVICES TO NIAGARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara issued a Request for Proposal for auditing services for relating to all reasonable and necessary outside auditing services to the County of Niagara, including all departments thereof except Niagara County Community College, and

WHEREAS, four accounting organizations filed bids on or about mid-September 2019, of which all bids have been reviewed by the Department of Purchasing, Office of Treasurer, and the Department of Audit, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the bidding procedures applicable to bids sought from professional organizations and further based on the current, general and specific auditing needs of the County of Niagara, the Department of Audit has recommended acceptance of contract with Drescher & Malecki LLP, CPA, and

WHEREAS, Drescher & Malecki LLP, CPA is experienced in performing government audits and consulting services in New York State; their reputation, knowledge, and experience in auditing numerous counties, schools and local municipalities are an advantage in the selection of this firm; Drescher & Malecki LLP, CPA was founded on the principle of providing their clients with the same high quality level of service expected from a national firm yet with the dedicated involvement that can only be developed by personal attention; they are dedicated to the pursuit of imaginative, intelligent and proactive solutions to all of our accounting and consulting service needs, all are positive factors in the Department of Audit's recommendation, and

WHEREAS, Drescher & Malecki has now proposed to extend our audit current contract to provide similar services for each of the next five fiscal years, and

WHEREAS, Drescher & Malecki agreed for consideration for the extension they will limit annual increases to just 2.5% for the duration of this contract, and

WHEREAS, Niagara County is cognizant of the impact and unpredictability of the current economy, and the imminent cost volatility into future years. It is in the best interest Niagara County agrees and accepts this proposal, and

WHEREAS, under Niagara County's Purchasing Guidelines, the Niagara County Legislature and the requisite committee(s) have the discretion to waive the Requests for Proposal for a professional services contract, and

WHEREAS, prior to the execution of the engagement agreement, the County Attorney will review the engagement agreement for approval as to legal form, language and compliance, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that following the County Attorney's review, the agreement engaging Drescher & Malecki LLP., CPAs for all reasonable and necessary outside auditing services required by the County of Niagara, shall be executed pursuant to the Niagara County Contract Policy.

MH - 2023 BUDGET MODIFICATION - OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara is concerned about the welfare of all of its citizens and, as such, formed the Niagara County Opioid Task Force (OASIS) in 2016 in recognition of the broad impact the opioid epidemic was having on our communities, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara entered into and joined a range of litigation against manufacturers, distributors, and sellers of opioids in 2018, and

WHEREAS, the NYS Attorney General's office and separately States Attorney Generals' offices have negotiated numerous settlements with manufacturers, distributors, and sellers of opioid, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara is in receipt of funds designed to offset the expansive costs and impact of the Opioid crisis on County operations and funds designated for treatment, recovery, and prevention efforts, herein referred to as "Schedule C – approved uses", and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Department of Mental Health &Substance Abuse Services (NCDMH), as the Local Governmental Unit (LGU), is responsible for the planning and oversight of the service system to ensure the availability and continuance of services to individuals with mental illness and substance use disorders who are living in Niagara County, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Department of Mental Health (NCDMH), on behalf of the County of Niagara, has gathered data and input to create a plan for the distribution and use of Schedule C funds through stakeholder forums, public input sessions, and legislative committee meetings, and

WHEREAS, these planning efforts resulted in the identification of gaps, needs, and key priorities in several areas, including: clinical services; community supports/services; workforce training; diversity, equity, and inclusion; and prevention/outreach. strategies and solutions which require extensive funding investments have been referred to New York State Office of Addiction Services and Supports, and

WHEREAS, NCDMH put out a Request for Proposal (RFP) seeking proposals from Eligible Entities who will engage in activities, programs, and/or services for the purpose of Prevention and Stigma Reduction related to Opioid Use, Substance Use, and co-occurring Mental Health conditions, and

WHEREAS, through the Request for Proposal (RFP) process, Mental Health Advocates of WNY fiduciary agent for Anti-Stigma Coalition has been selected as the entity that best meets the NCDMH's requirements for the provision of Anti Stigma and Prevention activities, now, therefore, be it

APPROVAL OF LOW COST POWER BENEFIT TO EDWARDS VACUUM, INC. UNDER THE AGREEMENT FOR THE SALE & PURCHASE OF NIAGARA PROJECT POWER & ENERGY (ASPNPPE)

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara entered into the Host Community Relicensing and Settlement Agreement ("HCRSA") on June 25, 2005, and

WHEREAS, the HCRSA entitles the County of Niagara to 9 megawatts of low cost power allocation (at 70% load) from the New York Power Authority, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara has made the use of this low cost power allocation for economic development purposes as the top priority for that allocation, and

WHEREAS, there is presently an Agreement for the Sale and Purchase of Niagara Project Power and Energy ("ASPNPPE") that has been approved by the County of Niagara and NYPA and the Governor of the State of New York, and

WHEREAS, the ASPNPPE specifically provides that the County of Niagara could use its low cost power allocation for economic development purposes, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara has taken the necessary actions to fully implement the benefits contained in the HCRSA and the ASPNPPE, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara established the Empower Niagara Board by Resolution ED-021-07 to review applications for the use of low cost power for economic development by reviewing applications and to make recommendations to the Legislature of Niagara County, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara has previously awarded to Edwards Vacuum, Inc. for this same project under resolution ED-011-20, 120 kw (at 70% load factor), which agreement will expire on July 30, 2023 and for which Edwards Vacuum, Inc. has met each part of the previous application, and

WHEREAS, the Empower Niagara Board has reviewed the renewal request of Edwards Vacuum, Inc. for the use of low cost power to allow it to remain competitive in Niagara County and Edwards Vacuum, Inc. has met or exceeded each part of the previous application, including undertaking a major expansion to accommodate its growing business needs, introducing advanced technologies, increasing productivity and creating more job opportunities, and

WHEREAS, Edwards Vacuum, Inc. has achieved remarkable revenue growth, surpassing initial projections; signed a 15-year lease for its expanded facility which has demonstrated a long-term commitment to the region, and has installed electric vehicle charging stations on its premises, which all have a positive economic and environmental impact on the community, and

WHEREAS, Edwards Vacuum, Inc. has met or exceeded all the criteria qualifying its original project for consideration and the Empower Niagara Board is recommending approval of a three-year extension of the agreement, and

WHEREAS, the demand usage of Edwards Vacuum, Inc. will remain at 120kw (at 70% load factor) of low cost power, and

WHEREAS, the approval of the Edwards Vacuum, Inc. original application will not only maintain economic development in Niagara County, but also assist Edwards Vacuum, Inc. to remain competitive in its manufacturing and distribution of vacuum systems for the semiconductor, solar, and LED industries, and

WHEREAS, the Empower Niagara Board recommends the approval of the extension of low cost power allocation of 120kw (at 70% load factor) for a period of three (3) years commencing July 31, 2023 to Edwards Vacuum, Inc., now, therefore, be it
