# APPROVAL OF LOW COST POWER BENEFIT TO LOCKPORT ICE ARENA AND SPORTS CENTER INC. UNDER THE AGREEMENT FOR THE SALE & PURCHASE OF NIAGARA PROJECT POWER & ENERGY (ASPNPPE)

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara entered into the Host Community Relicensing and Settlement Agreement ("HCRSA") on June 25, 2005, and

WHEREAS, the HCRSA entitles the County of Niagara to 9 megawatts of low cost power allocation (at 70% load) from the New York Power Authority, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara has made the use of this low cost power allocation for economic development purposes as the top priority for that allocation, and

WHEREAS, there is presently an Agreement for the Sale and Purchase of Niagara Project Power and Energy ("ASPNPPE") that has been approved by the County of Niagara and NYPA and the Governor of the State of New York, and

WHEREAS, the ASPNPPE specifically provides that the County of Niagara could use its low cost power allocation for economic development purposes, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara has taken the necessary actions to fully implement the benefits contained in the HCRSA and the ASPNPPE, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara established the Empower Niagara Board by Resolution ED-021-07 to review applications for the use of low cost power for economic development by reviewing applications and to make recommendations to the Legislature of Niagara County, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara has previously awarded to Lockport Ice Arena and Sports Center Inc. for this same project under resolution ED-011-14, 400 kw (at 70% load factor), and then in 2020 a three-year extension of that agreement was granted under resolution ED-013-20, which will expire August 31, 2023, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Lockport Ice Arena and Sports Center, Inc. to enter into a third threeyear renewal, as the Empower Agreement has created savings to allow them to continue to employee various professional, make capital improvements to the arena/center, and provide economic growth to the community and

WHEREAS, Lockport Ice Arena and Sports Center Inc. has met each part of the previous agreement and they have continued to maintain several programs which draws nearly 200,000 visitors through its doors, thus the arena has become a large contributor to the local hotel and restaurant revenue through its programs and community activities, and

WHEREAS, this approval includes 250 kw previously designated to the Town of Lockport, for its designation with approval of the Empower Niagara Board, and 150 kw solely approved through the Empower Board, and

WHEREAS, the Empower Niagara Board has reviewed the renewal request from Lockport Ice Arena and Sports Center Inc. for the use of low cost power for developing, renovating and expanding its business in Niagara County, and

WHEREAS, Lockport Ice Arena and Sports Center Inc. has met all the criteria qualifying its project for consideration and the Empower Niagara Board is recommending approval of an additional three-year extension of the agreement, and

WHEREAS, the approval of the Lockport Ice Arena and Sports Center Inc. original application increased economic development in the City of Lockport, Town of Lockport, Pendleton and Niagara County as well as spurring job creation through economic activity within the City of Lockport, and

WHEREAS, the Empower Niagara Board has recommended the third extension of low cost power allocation application of 400 kw (at 70% load factor) for a period of three (3) years, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Niagara County Legislature hereby approves the Lockport Ice Arena and Sports Center Inc. application for a third three-year extension of 400 kw (at 70% load factor) low cost power benefits from Niagara County, pursuant to low cost power allocation received through the June 25, 2005 HCRSA and ASPNPPE, and be it further

RESOLVED, that following the County Attorney's review, the Chairman of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the Empower User Agreement of the agreement for Low Cost Power with Lockport Ice Arena and Sports Center Inc. for an additional three-year period.

#### A RESOLUTION CALLING ON GOVERNOR HOCHUL TO VETO A.04282B/S.3505B

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Legislature believes that increasing participation in the election process and reducing costs of government operations is good for our republic, and

WHEREAS, during the 2023 legislative session, Assembly Member Amy Paulin and State Senator James Skoufis reintroduced this legislation, which would move local elections to even-numbered years, and

WHEREAS, versions of this legislation were introduced in previous years and failed to reach the floor for a vote due to lack of support, and

WHEREAS, after the 2022 session concluded, the bill sponsor indicated that hearings would be held on the proposal through the Election Committee process, and

WHEREAS, no such hearings were held, and

WHEREAS, the proposed legislation circumvented the legislative committee process during the legislative session, limiting public input and understanding of the impacts, and

WHEREAS, there has been no financial analysis or operational analysis of the impacts on local Boards of Elections, and

WHEREAS, this legislation passed in the middle of the night on the last days of the legislative session, which is counter to the idea of an open and transparent government, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Legislature has many concerns with this bill, especially its diminishment of adequate attention to local issues and local voices, and

WHEREAS, by forcing local elections to compete against national and state-level campaigns, this legislation will decrease voters' attention to important local issues and deprive local candidates of appropriate platforms to explain their stance on issues, and

WHEREAS, moving local elections to even-numbered years would increase the cost of campaigns for local office due to advertising prices being driven up by demand from national and state level campaigns, thereby reducing the ability of local campaigns to get their messages out, and

WHEREAS, this legislation excludes elections to offices in New York City and all other cities and villages in New York State, as well as certain offices within all counties and towns, thereby negating any possible savings to local Boards of Election, and

WHEREAS, this legislation usurps Home Rule powers reserved by local governments and protected by the Constitution of the State of New York, raising questions of legality and constitutional authority, and

WHEREAS, local municipalities have had the ability to change their elections to even-numbered years for decades, and have chosen not to do so, and

WHEREAS, establishing the schedule of local elections is the right of the local government, supported by more than a century of precedent, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly Bill sponsor indicated that she had not received any messages of support for this proposal from any of the 57 Counties and 933 Towns across New York State impacted by this legislation, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Niagara County Legislature calls on Governor Hochul to strongly oppose this legislation and utilize her veto authority to reject this proposal, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Niagara County Legislature be, and hereby is, directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to Governor Kathy Hochul, Senate Majority Leader Andrea Stewart Cousins, Assembly Speaker Carl Heastie, Senate Minority Leader Robert Ortt, Assembly Minority Leader William Barclay, Assembly Bill Sponsor Amy Paulin, Senate Bill Sponsor James Skoufis, Assemblyman Angelo Morinello, Assemblyman Michael Norris, as well as to any others deemed necessary and appropriate.
