A local law providing additional retirement credit for Niagara County Community College faculty and administrative employees who are eligible for retirement

Be it enacted by the Niagara County Legislature of the

Section 1. Finding. The Legislature of Niagara County finds that it is in the best interests of the County to provide additional retirement service credits pursuant to Chapter 665 of the Laws of 1984 to NCCC faculty and administrative employees who are eligible therefore and who file an application for service retirement as specified therein.

Section 2. The County of Niagara shall participate in the retirement incentive program established by the State Legislature for NCCC faculty and administrative employees eligible to take part in such program pursuant to Chapter 665 of the Laws of 1984 and who file an application for service retirement as specified therein.

Section 3. The commencement date of the program shall be June 1, 1985. The open period for the program, as defined by the State Legislation, shall be sixty (60) days in length.

Section 4. The Local Law shall be effective upon the filing of this law with the Secretary of State.


