Local Law No. 2 of the year 19 89

A local law increasing the salaries of certain County officials

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the

City of Niagara, New York, as follows:

1. The salary of the County Attorney shall be increased in the sum of \$1,955, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the County Attorney shall be \$41,053.

2. The salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be increased in the sum of \$1,373 each, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be \$28,825 each.

3. The salary of the Public Defender shall be increased in the sum of \$1,550, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the Public Defender shall be \$32,550.

4. The salary of the Probation Director shall be increased in the sum of \$1,901, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the Probation Director shall be \$39,912.

5. The salary of the Purchasing Agent shall be increased in the sum of \$1,487, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the Purchasing Agent shall be \$31,235.

6. The salary of the Commissioner of Parks & Recreation shall be increased in the sum of \$4,853, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Parks & Recreation shall be \$39,882.

7. The salary of the Commissioners of Civil Service shall be increased in the sum of \$260.00 each, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the Commissioners of Civil Service shall be \$5,458 each.

8. The salary of the Director of Real Property Tax Services shall be increased in the sum of \$1,550, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the Director of Real Property Tax Services shall be \$32,550.

9. The salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be increased in the sum of \$2,575, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be \$54,075.

10. The salary of the County Auditor shall be increased in the sum of \$4,500, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the County Auditor shall be \$31,000.

This Local Law shall become effective immediately.
