**REGIONAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN NIAGARA AND ERIE COUNTY  
TO PERFORM AUTOPSY SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Niagara County and Erie County entered into an agreement in 2002 that allows the Erie County Medical Examiner's Office to perform all of Niagara County's autopsies, and

WHEREAS, the current agreement will expire December 31, 2014, and

WHEREAS, Erie County has offered us a three year agreement at \$1,751.00/autopsy and \$1,115/external exam for 2015 and 2016 with a small increase in 2017, and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial for Niagara County to continue this practice and promote regionalism and shared services between the Counties of Niagara and Erie, and

WHEREAS, prior to the execution of the agreement, the County Attorney will review the agreement for approval as to legal form, language and compliance, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that following the County Attorney's review, the County of Niagara does hereby agree to the terms and conditions contained in said agreement and authorizes the Chairman of the Legislature to execute the contract with Erie County and the Erie County Medical Examiner's Office.

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**A RESOLUTION TO CREATE THE NIAGARA COUNTY 911 ADVISORY BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Sheriff's Office operates and maintains the primary public safety answering point (PSAP) for the county, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County 911 Center receives every wireless 911 call from all consumers throughout the county, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County 911 Center dispatches fire and EMS services for all residents within Niagara County, except the City of Niagara Falls, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County 911 Center recently added the City of North Tonawanda Police, the New York State Police and the City of Lockport Fire Department to its dispatching duties, and

WHEREAS, as the Niagara County 911 Center continues to grow through consolidation, it is critical to assemble all the stakeholders it serves, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Niagara County Legislature hereby create the Niagara County 911 Advisory Board for the purpose of advising and making recommendations to the Niagara County Legislature, the Niagara County Sheriff's Office, and the Office of the Fire Coordinator & Director of Emergency Services, concerning 911 services and related emergency response services, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Sheriff and Fire Coordinator & Director of Emergency Services shall serve as co-chairmen of the Niagara County 911 Advisory Board; the initial membership of the 911 Advisory Board shall consist of stakeholders from the various law enforcement agencies, fire departments, and other emergency responders, as well as other interested parties as determined by the co-chairmen, such membership list to be provided to the Legislature prior to the first meeting of the 911 Advisory Board; upon the first meeting of the initial members, the 911 Advisory Board shall adopt by-laws governing their conduct, including procedures for altering the membership of the board and appointing members, however, the designation of the Sheriff and Fire Coordinator & Director of Emergency Services as co-chairmen shall not be altered.
