DRINKING WATER LEAD TESTING LABS

Listed below are licensed laboratories that provide information, sampling instructions and containers, and analyses for public water supplies in this area. As always, all environmental laboratories analyzing drinking water samples from the State of New York must be certified under the Environmental Laboratory Approval Program (ELAP) of the NYSDOH Wadsworth Center for each specific analyte being analyzed.

When you are concerned about the quality of your water, you are encouraged to contact the Niagara County Department of Health Division of Environmental Health for consultation. If you then choose to utilize the services of any of these labs, you should call them as soon as you decide. In all cases, it will be necessary to obtain sampling instructions, associated fees and appropriate sampling containers from the lab and this may entail a few days wait before sampling can begin. **In no case should you sample before contacting the lab.**
