All individuals age 12 -17 are eligible to receive a Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. Providers may accept a COVID-19 Immunization Screening and Consent Form completed by the parent or guardian, where the parent or guardian is not available in person or by phone to provide consent to vaccinate. Look for the form under “Vaccination of Minors Ages 12 – 17 Years” here: www.niagaracounty.com/health/Vaccine The minor should also bring ID/proof of date of birth (birth certificate, passport, learning permit/driver’s license, benefits card, etc.).

Recommendations for Pfizer Booster

- People 65 years and older and residents of long-term care settings **SHOULD** receive a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech’s COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months after their Pfizer-BioNTech primary series,
- People aged 50-64 years with underlying medical conditions **SHOULD** receive a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech’s COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months after their Pfizer-BioNTech primary series.
- People aged 18-49 years with underlying medical conditions **MAY** receive a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech’s COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months after their Pfizer-BioNTech primary series, based on their individual benefits and risks, and
- People aged 18-64 years who are at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure and transmission because of occupational or institutional setting **MAY** receive a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech’s COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months after their Pfizer-BioNTech primary series, based on their individual benefits and risks.

A patient’s clinical team is best able to assess booster eligibility and timing, clinical status of underlying medical conditions, risk of complications, comorbidities, and transmission/exposure/infection risk.
